Border Land School Division believes that healthy eating habits are important if a child is to develop to his/her fullest potential. The Division believes that the food and beverages sold in schools should be nutritious.

Nutrition

- All schools shall develop a Nutrition Policy.
- Schools shall include their nutrition policy as part of their annual school plan.
- Canteens and vending machines will sell only items from *the Foods to Serve Most Often* or *Foods to Serve Sometimes* lists. – *Manitoba School and Nutrition Handbook*
- All foods and beverages sold in schools for fund-raising purposes shall be nutritious.
- Food and beverages at classroom parties and special events should, whenever possible, be nutritious.
