

Hands On Learning

The Skills Canada National Competition (SCNC) is the only national, multi-trade and technology competition for students and apprentices in the country. Every year, more than 500 young people from all regions of Canada come to SCNC to participate in over 40 skilled trade and technology competitions. The competition will take place at the RBC Convention Centre in Winnipeg, MB! Students are able to watch Manitoba students compete at the national level in an Olympics style competition. Skills Canada is preparing to host 10,000 students per day. So far, over 7,000 students are registered to be there. In addition to the competition, an entire floor of the RBC Convention Centre will be providing hands-on activities called Try-A-Trade for students to try out including virtual welders and building booths.

Skills Canada Competition— Bring Students to Try-a-Trade



The Try-A-Trade exhibit is a great way for students to explore the trades. In the past students have been able to try virtual welders and automotive painting. There are over 40 different stations ranging from hair care, cooking, plumbing, bricklaying, mechanics and many more.

There are many interesting and lucrative careers in the trades and technologies on which the Canadian economy depends. In fact, many of these jobs are in high demand!

Exposing students to these opportunities early on is a key factor in broadening their career prospects and ensuring they understand the importance of acquiring essential skills while in school.

School Travel Subsidies

Spend an unforgettable day discovering skilled trade and technology careers! Travel subsidies of \$300 are available.

Bus/Travel Subsidy Guidelines:

- A maximum of 2 bus/travel subsidies may be applied for by one organization/school.
- Up to \$300 per bus, up to a total \$600 per school.
- An eligible bus constitutes a minimum of 15 students.
- Transportation may be booked through a transportation company of your choice.
- Subsidies are awarded on a 'first come first serve' basis.
- Confirmation of bus/travel subsidy(ies) will be sent to you via email.
